USMAP

USMAP enhances your job skills and shows your motivation for more challenging military assignments. Having a DOL and NC Certificate of Completion is a definite advantage in getting better civilian jobs since employers know the value of apprenticeships.

The program requires no off-duty hours and depending on how long you have been in the military you can be granted up to half of the required OJT hours for military experience.

There is no testing involved – the program only requires you to log your hours every day at work on the computer.
