1. We have received a copy of the MCAS Miramar Sports SOP and agree to the policies set forth.
2. Reschedules/cancellations must be directly reported to the Sports Coordinator by the team coach/alternate a minimum of 24 hours prior to game time or the game will be forfeited. For short notices for official military obligations (less than 24 hour notice), a Request for Reschedule Form signed by the team's Recreation Officer or Sergeant Major must be submitted to Sports Coordinator no later than 24 hours of cancelled game or game will be considered a forfeit. A Request for Reschedule Form is available at the Sports Coordinator's Office.
3. Any individual forfeiting a game/match will be charged a forfeit fee which will be equal to the amount paid to the officials for that particular sport, unless a 24 hour notice in writing is given to the Sports Coordinator or Athletic Director. This fee must be paid to the Athletic Department prior to the forfeiters next scheduled game/match. Failure to make payment will result in both an automatic forfeit in the next scheduled game and Unit Allocation Funds will be assessed for the amount owed. All unpaid forfeit fees from any other Intramural sport will delay entry into other leagues.
4. The Unit, Squadron, or Command Recreation Officer or Sergeant Major will acknowledge by signature the eligibility of each team and/or individual participating in Intramural competition, so that only eligible participants are entered. The Unit, Squadron, or Command Recreation Officer or Sergeant Major will be the point of contact for all complaints received, disciplinary issues, and game forfeitures.
